

APPLICATION PROCESS FOR NON-NORTH AMERICAN DIVISION STUDENT MISSIONARIES (SMs)

1. Applicant completes an interest form. After we receive this form, we send you an email with the application link, or you may complete the application online.
2. Your application is reviewed.
3. Applicant evaluation forms are sent to the reference names indicated on your application. Be sure to choose individuals who understand English and have active email addresses.
4. Your references are reviewed.
5. A skype or phone interview of about one hour is arranged with you. If all is well...
6. You receive, sign, and return the commitment form along with a US\$100 non-refundable deposit which applies to your total fundraising amount.
7. If everything looks good, we take your name to the Human Resources Committee for a decision on acceptance and tentative placement.
8. AFM approval letters are sent to you, your family, your career missionary family, and the project supervisor.
9. The Information Guide and a DVD of your project (or a similar one) are sent to you. Please **read the Information Guide** before training starts. Any questions should be directed to the Assistant to the Recruitment Director (tminikus@afmonline.org).
10. You must fundraise and submit to AFM at least US\$6,000 per person in donations from friends, relatives, fellow church members, business acquaintances, etc. before going to the mission project. Instructions on how to do this are included in the Information Guide. The funds you raise must be sent to AFM. **Remember, no one person/family can contribute more than 40% of the total needed!**
11. You complete the required immunizations for your country of destination.
12. Finally, you attend the 4-week summer training session (mid-July to mid-August) in Michigan before launching to your project. You're on your way!
